The Adolescent Suicide Prevention Program (ASPP) is a universal prevention program that strives to reduce suicide and suicide attempts among youth in Summit County and the surrounding areas by educating youth and caring adults about mental health, depression, suicide, help-seeking skills and available resources and works to reduce the stigma associated with mental health issues.

ASPP

- Provides school and community-based presentations to middle and high school aged youth utilizing the evidencebased SOS Signs of Suicide curriculum
- Provides staff trainings and support for schools to enable school staff to be equipped to identify and support youth in crisis
- Provides trainings for any group of adults who work with and want to support youth
- Provides training and ongoing advisory support to schools for the Sources of Strength program
